## U.S. Remains World's Biggest Military Spender in 2015: Research Institute

United States remained "by far the world's biggest spender" on military in 2015, according to a report released on Tuesday by the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI). According to the report, despite falling by 2.4 percent, a much slower rate of decline than in recent years, U.S. military spending was the highest globally at 596 billion U.S. dollars in 2015. The report pointed out that such a slower rate of decline was "the result of measures passed by the U.S. Congress to partially



protect military spending from previously agreed budget deficit-reduction

"U.S. military spending is projected to remain roughly level in real terms measures", and said that in 2016." Military spend-

ing in North America and Western Europe has been decreasing since 2009, largely as a result of the

global economic crisis, as well as the withdrawal of most U.S. and allied troops from Afghanistan

and Iraq. "There were signs in 2015, however, that this decline was coming to an end," according to the report. Meanwhile, "Western European expenditure was down 1.3 percent but this was the lowest rate of annual decline since the start of the recent fall in spending, which began in 2010." Britain, France and Germany have all announced plans for modest spending increases in the coming years "sparked by concerns about Russia and the threat posed by the Islamic State", according to the report.(Xinhua)

## **European Leaders Worried** about Refugee Children

SOFIA - European leaders here on Tuesday during a high-level conference expressed concern about the protection of refugee children, especially those who are not accompanied by their parents.

The record number of crises worldwide and their interaction make international environment insecure and more unpredictable, and children pay the heaviest price, Bulgarian President Rosen Plevneliev said while addressing the conference during which the Council of Europe launched its new Strategy for the Rights of the Child for 2016-2021.

"Despite our efforts, de-

spite the results achieved, we continue to witness daily violations of children's rights. Migrant children and unaccompanied children today are particularly vulnerable to violence," Plevneliev said before the eyes of more than 300 participants from the Council of Europe member states,

#### **Moscow Blasts** Washington for Blocking **Nuclear Disarmament**

MOSCOW - Russia on Tuesday criticized the United States for blocking the process of nuclear disarmament and accelerating its military buildup near Russia. "We note with regret that the lack of progress on nuclear disarmament is the result of a destructive and even openly hostile line of the Obama administration with regard to Russia," Russian Foreign Ministry spokeswoman Maria Zakharova said.

Promoting the disarma-

ment process has been hindered by reinforced U.S. military buildup near Russian borders, including the deployment of a missile defense system in Eastern Europe, she added. The current U.S. administration has launched the most ambitious modernization of the country's nuclear arsenal since the end of the Cold War with estimated costs of around 350 billion U.S. dollars over the next 10 years, said the spokeswoman. ...(More on P4)...(20)

TEHRAN - Iran's Foreign Minister Mohammad JavadZarif has called for the settlement of fierce conflict between Armeniabacked and Azerbaijani forces, saying sustainable peace must be established in the disputed border region of Karabakh.

#### **US Law to Recognise India as Partner** with Equal Status

WASHINGTON - The Obama administration was working with Congress for passing a law that would recognise India as a major partner of equal status, a senior Pentagon official said on Monday. SEOUL - North Korea can mount it on a Rodong missile," the South Korean official, with knowledge of South Korea's assessment of the North's nuclear program, told a small group of reporters on condition of anonymity. The Rodong missile can fire a 1 tonne (1,100 lb) warhead a distance of up to 2,000 km (1,250 miles), the official said. That would put all of South Korea, most of Japan and parts of Russia and China in range. "We believe they have the abilverified. ity to mount a nuclear warhead on a Rodong. Whether they will fire it like that is a political decision," said the official.(Reuters)

#### 1st S-300 Shipment to Head to Iran in Coming **Days: Russia Official**

TEHRAN - A senior Russian official says Moscow is to deliver the first shipment of its S-300 air defense systems to Iran in the coming days as part of a long-running contract between Tehran and Moscow.

"I don't know if this will happen today, but they (the consignments) will be loaded [for shipment to Iran]," ZamirKabulov, a department chief at the Russian Foreign Ministry, was quoted by Russia's Interfax news agency as saying on Tuesday.
