

Firewood, Sugar Prices up, Diesel Down in Kabul



KABUL - The prices of firewood and sugar have increased while that of diesel dipped during the outgoing week in the capital Kabul, market source said Saturday. Abdul Hadi, a worker at Wazir Abad Fuel Station in

Kabul, told Pajhwok Afghan News that the price of one liter of diesel decreased from 48 Afghanis to 47 Afghanis while the same amount of petrol remain unchanged at 46afs. Haji Hassan, a firewood seller in Charahi Shaheed

area of Kabul, said that the price of 560 kilograms of unpeeled oak increased from 7,200afs to 8,000afs Afghanis and the same quantity of cedar from 7,000afs to 7,500afs. He linked hike in firewood price to high demand. ...*(More on P4)...(17)*

ALP Man Who Killed Wife, Mother-in-Law Shot Dead

TALOQAN - An Afghan Local Police (ALP) member was killed inside a hospital after he had allegedly killed his wife and mother-in-law in northeastern Takhar province, an official said Saturday. Provincial police spokesman, Maj. Abdul Khalil Aseer, told Pajhwok Afghan News the slain ALP member had gunned down his wife and mother-in-law in Mogholan area of Khwaja Bahauddin district late on Friday. He said the killer was fleeing when police shot him injured. He was then shifted to hospital in the district center. 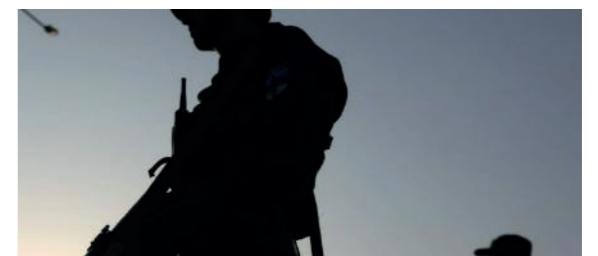
Tribal Elder Among 2 Gunned Down in Logar



PUL-I-ALAM - Unidentified gunmen have shot dead a tribal elder and a villager in the Mohammad Agha district of central Logar province, an official said on Saturday.

Governor spokesman Saleem Saleh told Pajhwok Afghan News the incident happened Friday evening in the Qandaraio locality. He said tribal elder Haji Sher Ali and another man Alam Khan were targeted by unknown armed men when they came out of the Mosque. He alleged the involvement of militants in the incident and added that police have launched investigation. ...*(More on P4)...(19)*

Militants' Ambush in Farah Leaves Three Policemen Dead



KABUL - At least three police force members and a contractor lost their lives in an ambush by the Taliban militants in Poshtrud district in Farah province, local officials said Saturday.

Nasir Mehri, spokesman for Farah governor, said the incident took place on Friday when the police force members were on their way to the center of the province. A local resident said the Taliban fighters had army uniforms and after stopping the police vehicle, they opened fire on them. Taliban has not commented on the report. Local officials have not provided details in this respect. (Tolonews)

Taliban Attempts to Maintain Drugs Production Amid Heavy Airstrikes

KABUL - The Taliban group in Afghanistan has stepped up efforts to shift tactics in a bid to maintain drugs production amid heavy airstrikes as part of a new campaign launched by the Afghan and US forces in southern Helmand province. The provincial government media office in a statement said the Taliban group has instructed its fighters to reconsider their strategy in maintaining the drugs production and smuggling. The statement further added that a



letter of the group has been obtained from Kajaki district which instructs the group's fighters to build drugs production facilities in places where they could not be spotted from the air. This comes as the commander of the NATO-led Resolute Support Mission and the US forces in Afghanistan Gen. John Nicholson said last week that ...*(More on P4)...(20)*

NDS Foils Suicide Attak in Ghor

KABUL - Intelligence forces have arrested a Taliban would-be suicide bomber in western Ghor province, National Directorate of Security (NDS) said on Saturday. A statement from NDS received by Pajhwok Afghan News, said the would-be suicide bomber named Asadullah aka Sadaqat Maihan, was trained for suicide bombing across the Durand Line. The detainee confessed he was involved in several terrorist

activities and was directed by Mullah Nik Mohammad, a Taliban commander to carry out a suicide attack, the source said. The statement said that the would-be suicide attacker wore a suicide vest and planned to carry out attack in Ghor province. However, he was arrested by NDS personnel before reaching to his goal. NDS did not provide information about the date of the detention. (Pajhwok)

Explosion in Kabul City Leaves Four Wounded

KABUL - A spokesman for the Kabul police commandment Basir Mujahid said the incident took place in the vicinity of the 1st police district of the city in Bagh-e-Qazir area. He said a magnetic bomb planted in a container belonging to the security forces went off at around 11:30 am local time, leaving three people wounded. However, another security official said at least four people were wounded in the explosion and one of them is in a critical condition.

No individual or group has so far claimed responsibility behind the incident. This comes as the anti-government armed militant groups have been attempting to carry out terrorist attacks in the key cities of the country, including capital Kabul amid mounting pressure on them in the battlefield. At least eighteen people were killed and several others were wounded after a suicide bomber detonated his explosives in Kabul city last month. (KP)

Foreign Forces Airstrikes Kill 12 Daesh Militants in Nangarhar

JALALABAD - At least 12 Daesh militants were killed and eight others were wounded in two airstrikes in Nangarhar province, local officials said Saturday. One of the airstrikes targeted the Daesh militants' hideout in Wazir Tangi area in Khogyani district where four insurgents were killed and eight others were wounded, said Attaullah Khogyani, spokesman for Nangarhar governor. Khogyani said eight Daesh fighters were killed a separate air-



strike by foreign forces in Achin district in the province. He did not provide more details in this respect. (Tolonews)
