Massive Attacks Foiled, 5 Militants Arrested in Kandahar

KANDAHAR - Police seized two Zaranj Rickshaws and a motorcycle full of explosives in southern Kandahar province late Saturday. Kandahar media office says insurgents planned to carry out massive attacks in Kandahar but there plans have been blocked. Five insurgents were arrested in connection with the explosives in Sozakar area of Dand district. According to Kandahar Media Center, Muhibullah a Taliban commander is among the five arrested. Kandahar Media Center adds that in another action police seized 45 Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs) in Maiwand district of the province. Kandahar is amongst the province where Taliban insurgents have strong presence. (KP)

NATO Official Warns Corruption Could Scare off Donors

KABUL - International aid to Afghanistan will be cut off if corruption is not checked and curtailed, said Maurits Jochems, NATO's Senior Civilian Representative in Afghanistan, on Saturday. In an exclusive interview with TOLONews, Jochems said that, given the many humanitarian and political crisis around the world, Afghanistan could become a lost hope for many if corruption is not addressed sufficiently under the new national unity government. In response to a question regarding if the international community would halt aid to Afghanistan if corruption



goes unabated, Jochems said this: "Yes, not today or tomorrow, but eventually that will be the consequence and I think President Ghani and Chief Executive Abdullah understand that very well." "So I am very hopeful that as ...*(More on P4)...*(8)
