12-Year-Old Girl Raped in Kapisa

MAHMOOD RAHQI - A twelve-year-old girl has been allegedly raped by the Afghan Local Police (ALP) forces in Nijrab district of northeastern Kapisa, the local elders said.
 Breaking down in tears, her father Abdul Basir claimed six local policemen came into their home at midnight and raped her daughter. "We appeal to President to bring these armed men into justice," Basir said.
 The family of the victim and the tribal elders, who have come to Kabul for justice, demanded the government to bring the rapists to justice.
 Protesting before the Parliament on Tuesday, the Nijrab elders complained the ALP forces harass the people instead to ensure their safety.
