Abdullah Says NUG Has Failed to Fulfill Some Commitments


KABUL - Abdullah introduces new Parwan governor, says NUG has failed to fulfill some promises but that they are working hard to address this.

KABUL - Officials have said that about half of Afghanistan's demands to Pakistan have been agreed to but details were not provided.

Officials from Afghanistan's Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MoFA) on Sunday said the Pakistani delegation agreed to about 50 percent of Afghanistan's demands in Saturday's talks.

However no details were provided on what the demands were

plemented to fight militants and to eliminate all insurgent safe havens in Pakistan, said MoFA spokes-

Kabul Municipality to Step up **Tax Collection Process**

KABUL - Kabul mayor said they will cancel the licenses of associations in the city if they fail to pay their taxes.

The Kabul Municipality says taxes for all associations will be collected regularly and for those that fail to pay, their licenses will be revoked.

Speaking after a meeting on Saturday, the acting mayor of Kabul, Abdullah Habibzai, said: "The goal of today's meeting is to sign anMoU between the Ministry of Finance and the Municipality of Kabul to clean up and cancel the licenses of associations, subject to their tax clearance."

According to him, 136,000 associations operate in Kabul. He said the municipality is trying to collect the revenue transpar-

Habibzai said in order to implement the agreement between the finance ministry and Kabul municipality, they will create a city police force toprotect them while they collect the taxes.

"We will use city police to implement this agreement. This police force will be hired or will be those ...(*More on P4*)...(10)

Ban on Mining Taking a Toll on Marble Industry

KABUL - A Kabul businessman says he has invested \$10 million USD in a marble processing factory but that it is not operational due to the lack of raw material.

The shortage of locally mined marble has brought a number of processing factories to a standstill, one factory owner, Ali Erfan, claims. He said there is a lack of raw marble which is proving to be a huge challenge for him.



Erfan, who owns Natural Company, said he invested at least \$10 million USD in two marble processing firms in Kabul and said he is running at a loss.

He said the equipment he has was imported from Italy.

"Despite insecurity, I invested a lot of money; but now I cannot work because there is a shortage of raw material," Erfan said.

He said they need 800,000 square meters of raw marble to make the company viable and at this level, there would be jobs for 200 people. "We can provide job opportunities for 200 people at the two companies and we hope to start within the next three months," he said.

The Ministry of Mines and Petroleum meanwhile admits marble factories are facing problems - especially as no contracts have been issued to mining companies.

The ministry's spokesman, AbdulqadeerMutfi, said contracts will be issued in the near future for the stone to be extracted.

"Government has outlined a clear mechanism for the country's mines. The mechanisms will remove all problems in contracts," Mutfi said.

Factory owners claim that illegal mining will increase if contracts are not issued by government soon. (Tolonews)

Nearly 100 Insurgents Killed in Afghan Operations: MoD

KABUL - The ministry of defense said the Afghan security forces have made a number of gains in fighting insurgents around the country.

At least one hundred insurgents were killed in the past 24 hours during Afghan forces' operations across the country, the Ministry of Defense said on Sunday.

Ministry spokesman DawlatWaziri said that the insurgents were killed in Faryab, Kandahar, Ghazni, Nangarhar, Helmand, MaidanWardak and Logar provinces.

1 Police Killed, 6 Wounded in Farah Attack

FARAH CITY - One policeman has been killed and six others wounded in a clash in the BalaBolok district of western Farah province, an official said on Sunday.

Deputy police chief Gen. Abdul RaziqSherzad told Pajhwok Afghan News the militants stormed a security check-post in Farahrod area late on Saturday night.

He said one policeman was killed and six other wounded. The injured had been evacuated to the hospital and some were in critical condition. Taliban insurgents were also suffered casualties, he said, adding without going into details. There has been so far no word from Taliban in this regard. (Pajhwok)




