

# 6 Security Personnel Dead, 14 Hurt in Badakhshan Fighting

FAIZABAD - Six security personnel have been killed and 16 others, including two civilians, wounded during a clash with the Taliban in northeastern Badakhshan province, a well-placed source said on Tuesday.

A security official, who wished to go unnamed, confided to Pajhwok Afghan News the clash took place during a clearing operation in the Yafal Bala locality on the outskirts of Faizabad, the provincial capital.



The fighting was still underway in the area where four Afghan National Army (ANA) soldiers and two policemen had been killed so far. Eight soldiers and five policemen and two civilians have been wounded, the sources added.

Crime branch chief, Sakhi Haideri, confirmed the fighting was still ongoing but he did not comment on casualties among security forces. The Taliban have not yet commented about the clash in Faizabad. (Pajhwok)

## Former Jihadi Commander Killed in Kapisa Blast

MAHMOOD RAQI - A former jihadi commander, Fathullah, has been killed and his colleague wounded in a blast in the Nijrab district of central Kapisa province, an official said on Tuesday.

Police spokesman Mohammad Ayub Yusufzai told Pajhwok Afghan News the explosion took place in Ghaus valley late on Monday when the vehicle Fathullah and his colleague were traveling in struck a roadside bomb. Yusufzai blamed militants for the bomb attack, saying an investigation had been launched into the incident.

Mahmood, a resident of Nijrab, said Fathullah was a famous jihadi leader and played an impressive role in maintaining security in the district. With the killing of the Hezb-I-Islami Afghanistan... (More on P4)... (15)

## Civilians Among 7 Dead in Fresh Logar Clashes

PUL-I-ALAM - Two civilians and five Taliban have been killed in an overnight clash with security forces in the Charkh district of central Logar province, an official said on Tuesday.

Governor Spokesman Saleem Saleh told Pajhwok Afghan News the clash took place in the Pangram district between security forces and the Taliban on Monday night. Security forces escaped unhurt in the gun battle.

Syed Ahmad Shah, a tribal elder, confirmed a clash erupted in the area last night. He said three civilians of a family, including a woman, were killed in the overnight clash. "A mortar shell fired by security forces from the direction of district centre struck a house in the area, killing three people of a family," he said. Saleh, however, said it was not



exactly made cleared the mortar that killed civilians fired from which side. He said the issue was being investigated. Qasem Khoshwal, the provincial council member, said the residents of Pangram complained civilians had been killed in security forces firing. He said the public representatives would investigate the issue and share the matter with security officials. Taliban have not yet commented about the incident.

## Taliban District Chief Among 8 Rebels Dead in Clash, Blast

HERAT CITY - Eight Taliban, including their shadow district chief, have been killed separately during a clash and blast in the Keshk-e-Kohna and Shindand districts of western Herat province, an official said on Tuesday.

Jilani Farhad, the governor's spokesman, told Pajhwok Afghan News the clash erupted when insurgents attacked a security forces' convoy in Koh-i-Antan locality of Qalamin village of the district on Monday night.



He said retaliatory firing by the security forces' caravan resulted in the killing of Mullah Ghani alias Mullah Mobariz, a Taliban shadow chief for Keshk-e-Kohna, and his five other associates. No casualties were inflicted on security personnel during the firefight, he... (More on P4)... (18)

## 5 Insurgents Detained in Nangarhar

JALALABAD/KANDAHAR CITY - Intelligence officials have detained five insurgents in various districts of eastern Nangarhar province, where six rebels joined the peace process, officials said on Tuesday.

Nangarhar governor's spokesman, Attuallh Khogyani, told a news conference here that National Directorate (NDS) personnel detained three persons from a car in Ghazi Amanullah Khan Township in Rodat district. He said the detainees were expert in planting roadside bombs.



Landmines, silencer-fitted pistols and bullets were recovered from the detainees, said Khogyani. He said NDS forces had also nabbed a Taliban member Mohammad Jalal in Batikot district. His comrade, Ilyas Mohammad, had also been detained in Achin district, he added.

## Prisoner Hangs Himself in Sar-I-Pul Jail

SAR-I-PUL - An inmate in the central jail of northern Sar-i-Pul province has allegedly committed suicide by hanging himself, an official said on Tuesday.

The inmate, a former policeman Abdul Ghafoor, had been sentenced to one and a half years imprisonment a month ago over negligence in duty at a military base, said Zabihullah Amani, the governor's spokesman.

He told Pajhwok Afghan News the former policeman was resident of Baghawi village of Sar-i-Pul city. Ghafoor hanged himself in the wee hours of Tuesday. An investigation into the incident was underway, he said.

The provincial council head, Mohammad Rahmani, said the policeman hanged inside of the prison's mosque. He added prison's officials mistreated prisoners and sometimes beat them. (Pajhwok)

## Suicide Bomber Blown up by Own Explosives in Zabul

QALAT - A suicide bomber was killed before he reached his target in the Shahjoi district of southern Zabul province, an official said on Tuesday.

Wazir Ahmad Jawadi, the district chief, told Pajhwok Afghan News the incident took place Monday evening. The explosive jacket the attacker was wearing did not explode due to a technical fault

## Two Policemen Killed in Clash with Gunmen in Parwan

KABUL - The clash took place in Charikar city, the capital of the province, Provincial Police Chief Mohammad Zaman Mamuzai said.

## 5 Dead, 4 Hurt in Samangan Traffic Accident

AIBAK - Three men and two women were killed on Tuesday when the vehicle they were travelling in crashed into a truck in Hazrat Sultan district of northern Samangan province.

Another four people in the minibus were injured in the early morning accident, Samangan police spokesman Munir Rahimi told Pajhwok Afghan News.

He said the dead included three men and two women and three men and a woman were injured in the crash. Rahimi blamed the fatal accident on high speed and drivers' carelessness. The injured were evacuated to the provincial civil hospital.


