TOLO TV Staff Remembered on 2nd Anniversary of Attack


KABUL - January 20, marks the second anniversary of the Taliban suicide car bombing that killed seven TOLO TV staff members and wounded 26 others, including passers-by.

Among those killed were three loyal and dedicated female employees.

The explosion happened on Darulaman Road when a suicide bomber rammed his car into a staff bus that had been taking the TOLO TV employees home.

This was the first major attack on a media organization since the ousting of the Taliban regime in 2001.

Noor Warns of Civic Action if Jamiat-Govt Talks Fail



KABUL - The ousted governor of Balkh, Atta Mohammad Noor, again said at a gathering in Mazar-e-Sharif on Saturday that his supporters are ready to take civic action if talks between government and Jamiat-e-Isla-

Noor called the incumbent government a coalition state and a government contravening the Constitution. "When I called you for 'green' action, it will be a move where you will take to the streets in massive groups and chant your demands. If your voice is heard and the problem is solved then good; otherwise we will move towards 'orange' action. What is an orange action? It is a move where we

will go out in massive groups and

close roads and government offices in

the entire province," he said.

Noor, who is also the CEO of Jamiate-Islami Party, said his resignation was tied to that of the president and the chief executive. Paktia Blast Leaves 1 Civilian Dead

GARDEZ - One civilian was killed and another wounded in a magnetic bomb blast in Gardez, the capital of southeastern Paktia province, on Saturday morning, an official said.

Abdullah Hasrat, the governor's spokesman, told Pajhwok Afghan News the explosion took place on the limits of 2nd police district at around 10:30am this morning.

He confirmed the explosion was triggered by a magnetic bomb that left one individual killed and another wound-

A well-placed source, speaking on the condition of anonymity, told Pajhwok that the person killed was Samiullah, finance officer of labor and social affairs Department.

An eyewitness, Ajmal said "A heavy explosion broke out between two corolla type vehicles and the casualties' toll may be higher."

However, the Provincial Civil Hospital official said they received one injured from the site of blast. There was no immediate claim of responsibility for the blast. (Pajhwok)
