# WJ Again Summons Ulumi Over Spiraling Insecurity

KABUL - As many as 64 Wolesi Jirga (WJ) members on Wednesday signed agreed to summon minister of interior to brief the august house about growing incidents of violence that has been plaguing the country for weeks and the group attack on the parliament building.

In line with article 92 of the internal principles of the house, a minister could be summoned after approval of 20 percent lawmakers. At least 50 members of the lower house make 20 percent of the total strength of the house.

Last Saturday, Interior Minister Noorul-Haq Ulumi and other high ranking security officials were summoned to the house to update the house about the parliament attack and other incidents of insecurity, but Ulumi did not



satisfy members of Wolesi Jirga. Speaker Abdul Rauf Ibrahimini said the form

which was signed by at least 64 lawmakers was submitted to the administrative

panel of the house for further proceedings. (Pajhwok)

KABUL - As many as 85 members of Wolesi Jirga or lower house of parliament in a letter wanted the names of those lawmakers revealed who remained absent from the house session for long. ## US Praises ANSF Quick Response to Terror Acts



WASHINGTON - The Afghan National Security Forces (ANSF) have come a long way in defending and securing their country, the United States said Tuesday as it praised the security forces in successfully and quickly responding to the terrorist suicide attack in Kabul earlier in the day.

"Looking at the response of the Afghan national security forces, the speed with which they got on scene and the efficiency with which they dealt with the attackers, I think, shows that the training and assistance that we've been giving them has been effective," the State Department Spokesperson, John Kirby, told reporters at his daily news conference. Responding to questions on the latest terrorist attack in Kabul, Kirby said during this summertime it is not unusual or atypical to see more Taliban attacks, not just in Kabul but elsewhere in Afghanistan during the summertime.
