WASHINGTON - The Islamic State is posing a threat and competition to the Taliban in Afghanistan, a top American general told lawmakers Thursday adding that there has been significant improvement in relationship between Kabul and Islamabad under President Ashraf Ghani.

"The current relationship appears to have improved since the election of President Ghani. It is clear that security in Afghanistan and Pakistan are linked," General Joseph Dunford, nomiJoint Chiefs of Staff, told members of Senate Armed Service Committee during his confirmation hearing. Both Afghanistan and Pakistan are working to ensure that concrete steps are taken to enhance their bilateral relationship and
