

'Taliban Suffered Heaviest Losses in 3 Months': Police

LASHKARGAH - The police chief on Tuesday claimed Taliban insurgents had suffered heaviest losses during operations over the past three months in southern Helmand province. Brig. Gen. Nabi Jan Mullakhel told a police passing out ceremony here that the Taliban could no longer capture an area from security forces.

"During the past three months, police rendered many sacrifices in Kajaki, Sangin, Greshk



and Musa Qala districts, but we showed that we can protect the country's soil without foreign forces."

Mullakhel said the Taliban had been planning to capture some areas this fighting season, but they tasted defeat at the hands

of Afghan security forces and their attacks had subsided. "Our police are well-trained. We have established blockhouses in areas which the Taliban would cross, but now their movement has been restricted."

The police chief said the newly-graduated police officials would further strengthen police ranks. Col. Syed Naeem Himmat, the police training centre chief, said...*(More on P4)...(13)*

Man Arrested for Raping and Killing 3-Year-Old Child

KABUL - A suspect has been arrested over brutal rape and murder of a 3-year-old child in capital Kabul, the security officials said Tuesday.

Kabul police chief Gen. Abdul Rahman Rahimi informed regarding the arrest of the suspect during a press conference in Kabul today.

The 3-year-old boy was abducted, raped and brutally killed by a group of people and his dead body was left in a ruined place in 8th police district of Kabul city.

The issue was first shared during a general session of the lawmakers in the Lower House of Parliament - Wolesi Jirga earlier this week.



A lawmaker Abdul Rauf Inami said the child was brutally tortured as signs of torture were clearly seen on his body. According to Inami, the child had lost his teeth because the gang used stones to repeatedly hit on his face and head...*(More on P4)...(14)*

6 Militants Killed, 7 Hurt in Kapisa Operation

MAHMOOD RAQI - At least six militants have been killed and seven others wounded during a search operation by the military in central Kapisa province, an official says on Tuesday.

Unknown Gunmen Shot Ex-Taliban Shadow Governor



AYBAK CITY - Unknown gunmen shot a prayer leader, who was a former Taliban shadow governor, dead at a Mosque in northern Samangan province on Monday night, local officials said.

The incident took place in Lababi village, Dar-e-Sof district, when unidentified motorcyclists opened fire at Mawlawi Mohammad Isreal, a spokesman for Provincial Governor, Mohammad Sediq Azizi said.

"Mawlawi Mohammad Isreal was a former shadow governor of the Taliban before he was separated from the group" Azizi added.

According to Azizi, Taliban had several times demanded the prayer leader to rejoin the group but he denied.

No one has been arrested in this connection, he added.

So far, no group including the Taliban has claimed responsibility for the shooting. (Tolnews)
