

Kunar Displaced Families Call for Govt's Help



KAUBL - At least 40 families, who have been displaced after weeks-long clashes between the Taliban and Daesh militants in Chapa Dara district in the eastern province of Kunar over the past three weeks, called on government and aid organizations to provide them assistance as they are living in a "bad condition".

Dozens of families were displaced in April when the fighting between the two militant groups intensified. The 40 families have migrated to the eastern province of Paktia where they live under harsh conditions due to the warm weather.

"The conflict between the Taliban and Daesh in Chapa Dara [district] started many weeks ago," said Azizullah, member of a displaced family. "The two groups [Taliban and Daesh] asked us to help them in their fight and provide them food." "Threats from the Taliban forced 40 families to leave their homes and seek shelter in the city of Gardez in Paktia Province," said Kashmir Khan, a Kunar resident who has been displaced.

The internally displaced persons said they need help as they are living in a bad condition.

"We are living in Gardez in the warm weather. We ask relevant institutions to address our problems," said Matiullah, a Kunar resident. Paktia officials said efforts are underway to help the Kunar's displaced families who have been temporarily settled in Gardez.

"The [Paktia] governor continues his efforts to attract the attention of businessmen and aid agencies to help the displaced families," the Paktia governor's spokesman Abdullah Hasrat said.

32 Insurgents Eliminated in Kandahar Airstrikes



KANDAHAR CITY - At least 32 insurgents have been killed and 18 others wounded in airstrikes in southern Kandahar province, an official said on Saturday.

Police chief Maj. Gen. Tadin Khan told Pajhwok Afghan

News foreign forces targeted two vehicles carrying rebels and their hideouts in Shorabak and Maiwand districts on Friday evening. He said 27 rebels were killed, 18 others wounded and their vehicles, hideouts and weapons de-

stroyed. Five fighters were killed while transferring explosives in a vehicle in the Sor Baghal area of Maiwand district, said the police chief. The Taliban have not yet commented in these incidents. *(Pajhwok)*



Two Afghans Among 5 Arrested On Drug Smuggling Charges In India

KABUL - Police in New Delhi arrested five suspects, including two Afghan nationals, on charges of smuggling 150 kilograms of drugs, Indian news agencies reported on Friday.

The drugs worth 600 crores (more than \$87 million), according to India's News18.

The accused were trying to set up a full-fledged reconstitution factory in Delhi, Manishi Chandra, DCP Special Cell, said, as quoted by News18.

The modus operandi, according to police, involved soaking of jute bags, meant for carrying cumin and other household spices from Afghanistan to India, in a heroin-laden solution.

"Every empty jute bag actually concealed a dried solution of heroin in its fibers. Once the spices were removed, each jute bag would yield one kilogram of heroin," Chandra said.

The expose has revealed the sinister side of the spice and condiment trade between India and Afghanistan as the drugs were being smuggled in the garb of trade, the report said. *...(More on P4)...(10)*

'10 Civilians Killed in Badghis Airstrikes'



QALA-I-NAW - A public representative in Wolesi Jirga or lower house of the parliament on Saturday said 10 civilians were killed and two others injured in two airstrikes in north-western Badghis province.

Ziauddin Akazai, a lawmaker from Badghis told Pajhwok Afghan News that an airstrike in Akazai area of Bala Murghab district of the

province caused civilian casualties around 2am Friday night.

He said seven civilians were killed and another was injured in the incident. Five of the victims were from a single family while three others were from another family, he added.

Turkey Condemns Attack on University in Kabul



KABUL - Turkey has vehemently condemned a deadly terrorist attack on a university in the heart of Kabul.

At least eight people were killed and 33 others wounded in the assault, a Public Health Ministry official said a day earlier.

"We received the news with sorrow that a terror attack which took place at the Kabul University resulted in the loss of lives,"

the Foreign Ministry in Ankara said. In a statement, the ministry condemned the attack targeting an educational institution.

"We wish Allah's mercy upon those who lost their lives," The ministry wished speedy recovery to the wounded and conveyed condolences to the Afghan people and government. *(Pajhwok)*


