

# Teenage Girl Burnt to Death

JALALABAD CITY - A teenage girl has been burnt alive to death by her sister-in-law in eastern Nangrahar province, the provincial government spokesman said on Saturday.

Attaullah Khogyani told Pajhwok Afghan News the incident took place on Monday morning in Alikhel area in the limits of 3rd municipal district of Jalalabad city, the provincial capital. The 15-years-old Bibi Zenat, a 9th grade student, was thrown into a burning tradition oven (Tandoor) by her brother's wife.

Khogyani said security forces had detained Zenat's sister-in-law in connection with the incident but she hadn't yet confessed to killing the girl.

Zenat's parents were in Kabul and her brother was out home when the incident took place. (Pajhwok)



# 4 Heroin Producing Factories Destroyed

JALALABAD - Four heroin producing factories have been destroyed by security forces during a raid in the Sherzad district of eastern Nangrahar province, an official said on Saturday.

The governor's spokesman, Attaullah Khogyani, told Pajhwok Afghan News the operation kicked off on Friday in Malalai Ghondi locality was wrapped up this morning.

He said 25 Kalashnikovs, two pistols, one vehicle and one motorbike were also confiscated from the factories.

According to the spokesman, the drug producing factories belonged to notorious drug smugglers Juma Khan, Mohammad Agha and Hazrat. Khogyani said the factories were demolished by security forces with explosives and the security forces did not suffer casualties during the operation. (Pajhwok)

## Suicide Car Bomb Kills 4, Wounds 12

LASHKAR GAH - A suicide car bomb that hit Nad Ali district in the restive Helmand province left four people including the attacker dead and injured 12 others on Saturday, Omar Zawak, the spokesman for Helmand provincial government said.

"A terrorist riding explosive-borne car blew it up in front of the gate of local police training center in Nad Ali district at around 09:00 a.m. local time today killing himself and three local police personnel," Zawak told Xinhua.

Twelve more people including 10 local police and two schoolchildren sustained injuries in the incident, the official added.

Meanwhile, Qari Yusuf Ahmadi who claims to speak for the Taliban outfit in contact with media claimed of responsibility, saying several security personnel were killed and injured in the suicide attack. (Xinhua)

## 13 Dead, 12 Wounded in Taliban Infighting

HERAT CITY - At least 13 Taliban fighters have been killed and a dozen more wounded during a clash between two rival groups in the Shindand district of western Herat province, an official said on Saturday.

Herat police spokesman Jilani Farhad told Pajhwok Afghan News the clash took place between fighters of commander Mullah Samad loyal to Mullah Akhtar Mansour and a splinter group leader Mullah Rasool's commander

Nangyalai.

The infighting lasted late night and both the sides suffered heavy casualties, he said.

Ghulam Sarwar, a resident of the area, said both the sides had suffered casualties in the overnight clashes and now each group was attempting to take revenge on the other.

A Taliban spokesman Qari Yousuf Ahmadi said the clash was with security forces who sustained losses. (Pajhwok)

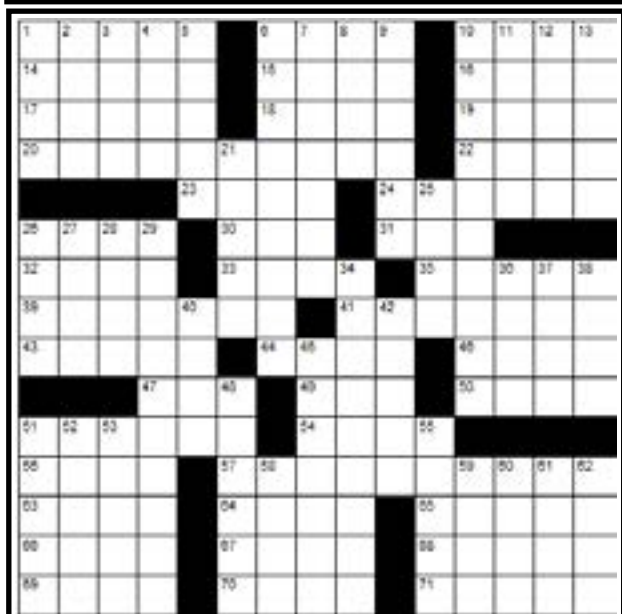
