



## Afghan Working Women Still Face Perils at Home and Office



KABUL - Minutes before Mena Mangal, a prominent Afghan journalist and parliamentary adviser, was shot dead by two men in Kabul, she had slammed the door of her parent's home after reminding them to pay the neighborhood shopkeeper 15 Afghani (20 cents). "Mena never forgot her duty towards our home and work. After years of struggle she had achieved success and happiness," said Anisa Mangal, Mena's mother, told Reuters, as she sat surrounded by her husband, four daughters, a son, grandchildren at her two-story home in eastern Kabul. "She did the right things ... worked very hard to become a professional woman." No-one has been arrested over the broad daylight killing, but police ... (More on P4)...(8)

## Qatar, Kuwait Denounce Deadly Blast in Herat

KABUL - Two important Gulf countries have denounced a deadly bomb explosion in western Afghanistan. Both Qatar and Kuwait condemned the blast that killed five children and wounded 20 other people in the Oba district of Herat province on Saturday. In Doha, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs renewed Qatar's position of rejecting violence and terrorism regardless of the causes and motives. In a statement cited by QNA, the ministry expressed condolences to families of the

## 3 Attackers Shot Dead by Kandahar Police

KANDAHAR CITY - Police in southern Kandahar province have killed three attackers after a clash. Two attackers stormed a police patrol in the 11th police district of Kandahar City. Policemen shot dead one assailant and the second managed to escape. Police spokesman Jamal Barakzai told Pajhwok Afghan News the fleeing attacker was also shot dead in the 12th police district. He said police suffered no casualties. In a similar incident, a third assailant was gunned down by police in Kabul Shahi area of the 1st police district, the



spokesman added. Targeted killings have increased in Kandahar province during the holy month of Ramadan. Mostly police and security personnel are being targeted. (Pajhwok)
