# Senators Call for Holding of Loya Jirga in Afghanistan

KABUL - Senators in the upper house of the parliament on Sunday called for holding of the Loya Jirga in order to overcome from the current situation in Afghanistan.

They have stated that problems are increasing day by day and it directs the country into complete crisis, demanding the Government to determine the date for holding of parliamentary and provincial council Election in the country.

Meanwhile a number of the senators in the upper house of the parliament have called for holding of tradition way of Election Loya Jirga.

Insecurity, poor economy, escaping of Afghans, interfering of neighboring countries,



having no clear policy against other countries are the major concerns of the senators who have expressed during the session today.

Senator Sher Mohammad Akhunzada said, "Government should do about the ongoing situation, Afghanistan parliament are illegally

working, the more it gets postponed the more it will ruin the country." However Zalmay Zabuli urged we should exert pres-

ures on Government, to hold the Loya Jirga, the domestic and Foreign Policy of Afghanistan should be determined."

## Turks Cast Ballots to Elect Lawmakers in Snap Election

ANKARA - Turkish voters went to polls on Sunday to elect 550 members of the parliament in a snap election just five months after the June 7 parliamentary election, in which the ruling party lost its 13-year majority and failed to form a coalition government.

The snap election is unlikely to result in the formation of a single-party government as no political parties seem able to get a majority, similar to the outcome of the last election. In

June, the ruling Justice and Development Party (AKP) founded by Turkish President Recep Erdogan failed to gain 276 seats in parliament, the number needed for a legislative majority, and formed an interim government, marking the loss of its 13-year majority in Parliament. But the AKP was still in the lead with 40.87 percent of the votes garnered, followed by the Republican People's Party (CHP) with 24.95 percent, ... (More on P4)...(3)
