Over 400,000 Support Independent Probe into US Bombing of Kunduz Hospital

MOSCOW - A petition calling for the support of US President Barack Obama to launch an independent investigation into the deadly bombing of the Kunduz hospital in Afghanistan by US forces has gathered over 400,000 signatures. Medecins Sans Frontieres (MSF), or Doctors Without Borders, a



medical organization that operates the hospital, initiated the petition, which was posted to the Change.org website, to investigate the October 3 US airstrike on the hospital.
