

# China, Iran to Cooperate on Resolving Afghan Problems

A Chinese media reported that contrary to American actions in Afghanistan and the country's failed military strategy, China, Iran and some other countries are working together to resolve Afghan security problems. China Org wrote on Saturday that nearly 17 years the Americans had nothing to do with their military plans in Afghanistan except defeat, and most American people also acknowledge it.



Beijing - Despite the failed American strategy, China, Iran, Russia and Pakistan are trying to save the country from the current complicated circumstances, the Chinese media continued. These countries have repeatedly developed strategies to promote peace and resolve Afghan security problems and

continue to cooperate and lobby for achieving these goals, the report added. "US military actions in Afghanistan not only have had no result, but have caused the country's death toll to grow 30 percent annually from 2014, which is considered the worst in Afghanistan in the past years, Chinese media reported.

China Org wrote, "Unlike the American actions, which more than 50 % of the country's population has already described it as defeat of the US in Afghanistan, the Chinese media said the four countries have sought to advance peace and security in Afghanistan and run the country out of the deadly situation. ## Militants Driven out of Some Villages in Jaghori, Malistan: MoD

KABUL - Military operations in the Jaghori and Malistan districts of southern Ghazni have been going on with security forces making advancement by clearing some villages, an official said on Saturday.

"Our forces are in a state of progress in Jaghori. MoD General Chief of Staff has the leadership the operation," Ghafoor Jawid, the ministry spokesman said.

Until now, Luman, Zarak, Hutqol and Pato villages have been cleared from the presence of terrorists, he said. The commander of Zafar Corps traveled to Farah province to assess and evaluate the situation in a comprehensive manner, after which extensive operations would be launched in the province, he said.

## Taliban Shadow District Chief Among 20 Killed in Kandahar



KANDAHAR CITY - At least 20 Taliban insurgents including a shadow district chief have been killed and 11 others wounded during operation in Maiwand district of southern Kandahar province, an official said on Sunday.

Maj. Ahmad Sadiq Isa, spokesman for 205th Atal Military Corps, told Pajhwok Afghan News security

forces conducted air-and-ground operation in the district. He said the Taliban's shadow district chief named Mullah Sharif among 20 rebels was killed and 11 others wounded. Four vehicles, weapons and some hideouts belonging to rebels were also destroyed during the raid. He added civilians and security forces suffered no casualties in the raid. (Pajhwok)

## 15 Daesh Rebels Join Peace in Nangarhar


JALALABAD - Fifteen Daesh or Islamic State (IS) rebels on Sunday surrendered their weapons and joined the reconciliation process in eastern Nangarhar province, an official said.

They joined the reconciliation process during a ceremony held at the National Directorate of Security (NDS) compound in Jalalabad.
