

'Endless Wars Must End,' Trump Tweets



KABUL - The tweet comes as the United State has been at war in Afghanistan for nearly two decades. US President Donald Trump on Saturday tweeted: "The Endless Wars Must End!"

Three days earlier at a rally of supporters, Trump said that the US troops "were supposed to be in Afghanistan for a short period of time," but they have remained in Afghanistan for close to 19 years. "It's time to bring them

home," he said. In early September Trump called off negotiations with the Taliban, and subsequently described talks with the group as "dead." Trump made the decision to scuttle the peace talks after the Tali-

ban admitted to an attack that killed at least 11 people, including a US soldier in Kabul. In early October a Taliban delegation met US envoy Zalmay Khalilzad, two sources told Reuters, which ...*(More on P4)...(10)*

Battling Security Guards of Rival Mps Kills Civilian: Eyewitness



BAGRAMI - In Bagrami district, in the eastern part of Kabul province, residents say at least one civilian was killed and two others were wounded during a gunfight between the security guards of two opponent lawmakers in parliament. Eyewitnesses claim that on Thursday night a clash erupted between security guards associated with Mohammad Asif Sediqqi, the second deputy of Meshrano Jirga (upper house of parliament), and Allah Gul Mujahid, a member of parliament from Bagrami. Residents said that the two members of the national assembly were fighting for tens of acres of

lands in the area. Akhtar Mohammad, a villager in Bagrami, said that he lost his brother during the clash between the two people. But both Mujahid and Sediqqi have said that they do not have any information about such an incident. "We are not aware of such incidents nor are we involved in them," said Sediqqi. "I don't know about this, my guards did not fight with anyone," said Mujahid. "There is no government that exists here. There is no rule of law and accountability. I don't understand ...*(More on P4)...(11)*

AGO Orders Further Probe into Nangarhar Brothers' Killing

KABUL - The Attorney General Office (AGO) on Saturday said it has appointed another delegation to further investigate into last month's killing of four brothers in a security operation in the capital of eastern Nangarhar province. In early September, the spy agency's special forces killed the four brothers, including an advisor to the Meshrano Jirga or Senate, during a night time raid in Jalalabad, the capital of Nangarhar. Following public outrage, President Ashraf Ghani ordered an inquiry into the incident and fired the spymaster, Masoum Stanikzai. The president directed the AGO to ...*(More on P4)...(12)*

KABUL - Sources within the Afghan Ministry of Interior on Saturday accused some lawmakers in the country's parliament for being involved in illegal imports of vehicles. The Ministry of Finance has stopped over 1000 such vehicles at customs over the past few months, but some members of parliament are trying to use their political leverage to escape custom taxes and get these vehicles on the market, said the source. "Those who are supposed to be drafting the laws are violating the laws," said Shoaib, a Kabul resident. Based on the traffic law, a license plate is intended for only for one car, but in some cases

the lawmakers are using a single license plate—one that allows special privileges—for

several cars and even allowing their relatives to use the plate. Khan Mohammad Wardak, a

member of the Afghan parliament, uses a single number plate for four vehicles. The spe-

cial plate allows him privileges in terms of security. "The position of a lawmaker is superior to the position of a minister. I am compelled to keep guards for my security," said Khan Mohammad Wardak, a member of the parliament. Meanwhile, another parliamentarian, Fida Mohammad Ulfat Saleh, has acknowledged that he uses several vehicles with the same plate. "Yes, I have three vehicles, but all the vehicle identifications are shared with the security institutions," said MP Fida Mohammad Ulfat Saleh. But Abbasin, a resident of Kabul, says of MPs: "They are not abiding by the law, they never respect traffic laws." (TOLO News)


