

# Helmand Governor Claims Controlling Land Grab, Injustice

LASHKARGAH - The Helmand governor, who took office three months ago, on Monday claimed preventing injustice and land grab in the southern province. During a meeting with tribal elders, Mirza Khan Rahimi said his administration was giving its best shot to maintaining security and ensuring development. "We have received complaints that one piece of land has been allotted to several people. We have also reports that land for parks, mosque and public areas have been sold," he said. The governor has ordered the prosecution office, National Directorate of Security (NDS) officials and

# Filmmaker Torches Documents, Movies in Herat

HERAT CITY - A filmmaker in western Herat province on Monday set ablaze hundreds of his documents and movie-making equipment to register his protest against the government for not supporting the emerging cinema industry. Abdul Rahid Azimi torched his 350 CDs of documentary films, 200 CDs of photos, short films and 100 pages documents, appreciation letters, certificates and newly-written film stories in front of the Information and Culture Department in Herat City. Azimi, who has been in the industry



for the past 14 years, said his action was in protest against the government's inattention to their profession and achievements and lack of support. "Today, I set afire the documents and memories of my life's 14 years in the presence of media to draw the attention of the unity government leaders to the cinema field. If it was not a big sin, I would have torched myself too," he said. "The government has made us struggling with many problems," said another member of the industry, ...*(More on P4)...(16)*

## ANSF Kill 8 Terrorists, Including Al-Qaeda Commander

SHARAN - The National Directorate of Security (NDS), in a statement on Monday, said that at least eight militants, including a senior al-Qaeda commander, were killed in its forces' operations in Paktika province. The statement said that the NDS' offensive targeted the militants' positions in Mokhtar Mina area of Gomal district in which the al-Qaeda men, including commander Khuram alias Qasim, Junaid, Hassan and Khadma were killed. ## 2 Notorious Taliban Commanders Eliminated

MAHMUD RAQI - Two notorious Taliban commanders from central Kapisa province have been killed by security forces in eastern Nangarhar province, an official said on Monday. Kapisa police chief, Brig. Gen. Abdul Karim Faiq, told Pajhwok Afghan News the insurgent commanders, had recently traveled from the Tagab district of Kapisa to Nangarhar. He alleged commanders Maulvi Wahdat and Mullah Najib had come to Nangarhar to fight against Islamic State members. ## Mother of Martyred Policeman Calls for End to War

MAZAR-E-SHARIF - The mother of a policeman killed six months ago by insurgents in Balkh province has appealed to government and to insurgents to end the war and reach a peace agreement. Bebe Gul said the death of a child was too heavy a burden to carry and that no mother should have her heart broken in this way under such circumstances. Bebe Gul's son, Abdul Qayoum, was a special forces policeman who died six months ago in a suicide attack on the attorney general's office in Balkh province. Abdul Qayoum has left behind six children, all of whom now have to be cared for by their 68-year-old grandfather and 56-year-old grandmother. "The enemy is not letting us calm down. I lost my son and we have to take care of his six children. Day and night I cry and I pray that the person who killed my son and others who killed our children be punished," said Bebe Gul. With tears streaming down her face, Qayoum's distraught mother said that the death of a child was a very painful experience for a mother. "May God save us, all this war as well as killing is enough now. We cannot tolerate it anymore," Bebe Gul said. Two of Qayoum's children, Abdul Qasim, 10, and Abdul Fahim, 12, are at school and ask only that they can continue their studies. "I want be educated and I want to be an engineer in the future," said Abdul Qasim. *(Tolonews)*
