EU Provide 25m Euros to Afghanistan for Polio Eradication

KABUL - The European Union (EU) has contributed 25 million Euros in support of Afghan children on the move and ending polio, according to a statement on Sunday. The four-year grant would enable UNICEF and partners to better reintegrate children on the move, and to provide them with a protective environment, a statement from the EU said. It would also support UNICEF, the World Health Organization (WHO) and the Government of Afghanistan in their endeavor to eradicate polio. "This Euros 25 million grant for both children on the move and polio eradication illustrates the

European people's support and dedication to improving the lives of the most vulnerable children in Afghanistan" said Ambassador Pierre Mayaudon, Head of European Union Delegation to Afghanistan. The grant launched today would provide opportunities to protect Afghan children on their migratory journey increase their resilience by strengthening their coping mechanisms, including the provision of psychosocial support and would facilitate their reintegration into their communities.

Abdullah off to New York for UN General Assembly

KABUL - Chief Executive Officer (CEO) Dr. Abdullah Abdullah on Sunday left for the United States to attend the 73rd United Nations General Assembly. The CEO, heading a high-level delegation, would take part in the assembly on behalf of the unity government articulate Kabul's views on different issues, a statement from his office said. Abdullah will underline the need for counter-terrorism, counter-narcotics, regional and international cooperation with Afghanistan, as well as preparations for parliamentary and district council elections. The CEO would also explain the steps the government has taken to curb corruption, promote education and women empowerment,

besides plans for economic development. Efforts to achieve sustainable development, internal and regional challenges are the issues in Afghanistan that would be spotlighted by the CEO during UN General Assembly. According to the statement, Abdullah will meet the UN secretary-general, prime ministers and foreign ministers of different countries on the sideline of the 73rd UNGA session. On the margin of the important event, the statement added, Abdullah would participate in a banquet to be hosted by US President Donald Trump. Acting Foreign Minister Salahuddin Rabbani and other high-ranking officials are accompanying the CEO on the trip. (Pajhwok)

In Helmand, Women Candidates up Against Odds

LASHKARGAH - Women candidates for Wolesi Jirga from southern Helmand province grumble about cultural and security impediments to displaying their portraits and banners in crowded places of the city. Helmand province has eight seats in the lower house of parliament, including two berths reserved for women. A total of 92 individuals, nine of them women, are in the electoral race from the restive province. Jameela Niazi, a female candidate, told Pajhwok Afghan News complained they were unable to conduct their election campaigns the way their male counterparts were doing.
